

# Scholarship Statement: Sociology

Meaningful scholarship is a basic expectation for tenure track faculty in the department. While sociological research methods are varied—ranging from quantitative research designs that employ sophisticated statistical modeling to interpretative research designs that are qualitative in nature—research that demonstrates scholarly growth and expertise must be subjected to the scrutiny of qualified peers. Further, while scholarly output such as conference presentations (which are strongly encouraged), book chapters, book reviews, encyclopedia entries, and the like make contributions to the discipline, it is ordinarily expected that tenure track faculty will have at least two articles accepted for publication in peer reviewed journals by the time they apply for tenure.
