OCICU **MUST** receive the drop notification from the member school **NO LATER THAN 5PM MST** on the day prior to the **OCICU FEE EARNED DATE**.

Per OCICU policy all fees are earned in full on the published OCICU Fee earned date (9th day of the term).

DROPPING CLASSES Accelerated and Weekend classes dropped before the 1st Class result in 100% refund. Those dropped during the week before session begins will be assessed a \$25 drop fee. Courses dropped after the 1st class but before the 2nd class will receive 80% refund. For those dropped after the 2nd class there is no refund. Students will be billed for any tuition that remains unpaid. Drop Slips are available in Frederick and on the Continuing Studies website for download. Fax all drop slips to 301-682-5247 or bring them in person to the Frederick office. Drops are not official until they are received in the Frederick office. Out of consideration to other students an the instructor, it is strongly urged that those who must drop classes do so as early as possible. This policy facilitates decisions on classes running and allows students on the waitlist to register and prepare for class.

ADDING CLASSES: Weekend College students may add a course after missing the first class only with the instructor's permission. Drop/Add forms may be obtained from the Continuing Studies office in Frederick or on the website for Continuing Studies. Accelerated Studies students may NOT add classes after the first class has met!
