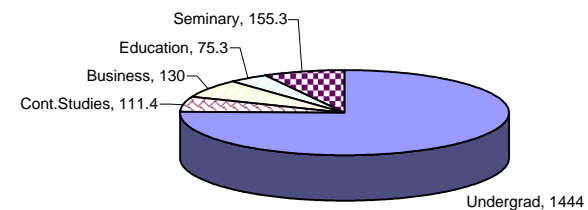
Graduate:
