No paper soiled with food or paint.
No wet paper.
No newspapers or cardboard*

YES

- computer and office paper (staples and paper clips are ok)
- unwanted mail
- all other clean and dry paper

NO

- glossy paper (magazines and catalogs)
- packing material (styrofoam or plastic wrap)
- food soiled papers (plastic or wax coated liners and pizza boxes)
- wax paper, carbon paper, hard-backed books, and beverage containers such as milk or juice cartons
- paper or cardboard contaminated with paint, chemicals, water or anything else
- foil gift wrap, paper towels, napkins or tissues

* THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RECYCLABLE BUT NOT IN THESE RECEPTACLES.

- creamer bottles
- mouthwash and cough and stomach medicine

- glass
- aluminum
- tin
- plastics other than #1 & #2
- plastic food wrappers including chip bags
- yogurt or butter containers (#5)
- sour cream or dip containers
- plastic cups or straws
- deodorant
- cereal-on-the-go plastic bowls
