Judy was instrumental in helping to create the David S. Zocchi Brain Tumor Center at Monmouth Medical Center; the first brain tumor facility of its kind in the central and southern New Jersey region. She continues her work to fight brain cancer through fundraising and awareness raising programs.

She has lectured on campus for the Education Dept.; and continues to volunteer as a class agent for the Mount Annual Fund. Judy is the first woman to receive the Brute Medal.
