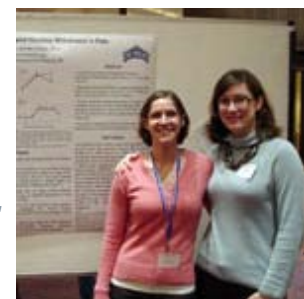
A group of Mount business students taught second-graders the basics of buying, producing and then running a
