***Past Business***

***Current Business***

- **CAB Proposal** – SGA and CAB currently share an office. It is SGA’s intention to convert the underutilized Wellness Center Conference Room into the CAB Headquarters. While this is strongly supported by SGA as well as CAB, administration has yet to vote on this proposal.
- **Constitution** – Over the summer SGA Executive Board worked extensively on the SGA Constitution. There are nine pages of changes. If a student wants an original SGA Constitution, Exec.
